### Depth of Mercy

Charles Wesley, 1707-1788

**我们借着爱子的血，得蒙救赎，过犯得以赦免，乃是照祂丰富的恩典。这恩典是神用诸般智能聪明，充充足足赏给我们的。（弗 1:7-8）**

基督徒信主的年日愈长，就愈容易陷入一个危机，即渐渐忽视救恩的意义与宝贵。当我们仔细思索这救恩的时候，就会发现神所赐的救恩是何等丰富的，且是存至永恒的。神的无量仁慈恩典，保罗在弗一章中指出有六：

- （一）罪得赦免——神不追究我们所作的一切，没有人能再控诉我们。
- （二）成为圣洁——不但赦罪且有力量成为圣洁无瑕的人。
- （三）得儿子名分——天父接纳我们是祂的儿子。
- （四）在主里同归于——有资格进入一个永远的国，完全与主合一。
- （五）有圣灵的印记——永远的属于神，有圣灵的扶助。
- （六）得天上的基业——我们竟有机会永远拥有神所拥有的。

既然神给予我们这么大的永恒福气，我们的人生当怎样响应呢？

本诗作者 Charles Wesley 1707 年生于英国 Lincolnshire，Wesley 家族乃英国出类拔萃者，祖父及曾祖父皆出自牛津大学，且都为英国牧师，其父及其本人亦为牧师。19 岁进入牛津大学，毕业后受安立甘教会按牧，随即与兄 John 远航美国在 Georgia 任职，且展开布道活动。惜，美国之行带给他们兄弟极大失望、挫折、心灵破碎，不久即重返英国。1738 年 5 月 20 日五旬节主日，他参加由 Moravian 虔诚信众的聚会而得到复兴，当晚他重新奉献给基督，且经历圣灵的大能，得胜一切试探，享受释放的喜乐。后来两兄弟蒙神重用，带出英国大复兴，圣诗乃其复兴运动的工具，借着诗歌带出信息。Charles Wesley 一生共着有 6500 首圣诗。
