本诗是李理纳 (Haldor Lillenas, 1885-1959) 所作。他童年随父母从挪威到美国。在他 4-14 岁间,他们全家住在离城十三里的森林区,家中早晚有灵修。他没有上过主日学,但父亲经常以问答的方式教他们圣经。15 岁受洗。母亲过世后,家中失去了温暖,他离家去一农场工作。海滨垂钓,林间拾残枝都不能消除他内心的悲伤和空虚。1906 年的一天,他在街头听到一个年轻的女孩唱一首母亲期待她浪子归家的圣诗,深受感动,知道自己必须重生。两周后,他在一次的布道会中决志奉献,而后他的生命经历了惊人的改变。他开始在各街头布道的工作中事奉。

1909 年,他深感自己学识不够,决心去加州洛杉矶读神学。教会赠他一张单程的火车票,师母给了他数天的干粮,于是他身怀九元美金,踏上了火车。他备受艰辛地半工半读。有一天他在洛杉矶一条冷寂的街上,看到一个男人在殴打妻子,他前往劝阻,反被打伤了手,以致数周都不能练琴;这使他更感到街头传道的重要性。一年后他与女作曲家韦柏梅 (Bertha Mae Wilson) 结婚。他们终生同心合力从事圣乐事工。

李理纳一生共写了四千多首圣诗,他是 20 世纪重要的圣诗作家之一。


