这首富有乡村田园气息的圣诗在十九世纪十分流行。词的作者萧诺斯（Knowles Shaw,1834-1878）是美国南部农家子弟，熟悉田园生涯。萧诺斯十二岁时父亲去世，临终前把萧诺斯叫到床前对他说：“我要走了，这把小提琴是我惟一留给你的家产，你要靠它谋生，照顾你的母亲和二个妹妹；更要把一切荣耀归给主，随时要有见主的心理准备。”

萧诺斯在父亲去世后，白天在田里耕作，晚上在各种宴会场合演奏小提琴。不久他发现自音乐所得的收入超过农耕，就弃农从商。他物质生活日渐丰富，但灵性生活却日趋衰弱。有一天，他忽然想到了他父亲遗言的末二句，于是他开始求圣灵恩赐，以他的提琴和歌喉来引人归主。他成了一位音乐布道家，在事奉的二十五年中，引领了二万多人信主。有一次萧诺斯和一位同工谈到传道的艰辛，但看到有人归主则又万分喜悦；于是他根据诗篇 126:5-6 “流泪撒种的，必欢呼收割。那带种流泪出去的，必要欢欢乐乐地带禾捆回来。”写下了这首诗。现在通用的曲调，是美国圣乐作曲家孟纳（George A. Minor,1845-1904）所谱，并加上了副歌。

1878 年夏，他在德州达拉斯市，主领五周奋兴会后，搭火车去另一城市领会，不幸在离该市仅两里时，火车出轨，萧诺斯当场被主接去，正如他父亲的遗言：“要随时准备见主。”




