本诗的作者是英国人顾柏(William Cowper, 1731-1800)。顾柏六岁丧母,体弱多病、生性敏感、孤僻寡言。他 23 岁时曾因工作失意、婚姻受阻而精神崩溃,屡次想自杀。有一次,他驱车前往自家附近的河流自尽,在浓雾中迷失,最后他孤注一掷,往下一跳,谁知落脚处却是自己家门,进了屋,他感谢 神的旨意在暗中运行,写下了《主在暗中运行》(God Moves in a Mysterious Way)。1767年,顾柏和约翰牛顿(John Newton)成了知交,两人合编圣诗集,轮流主领聚会。这首诗根据撒迦利亚书 13:1"那日必给大卫家……开一个泉源,洗除罪恶与污秽。"顾柏虽然一生多病,但他的诗歌中并没有颓唐忧郁的气氛,而是赞美感谢神,一次又一次地,把他从悲观消沉中拯救出来。




