司布真師母自壁爐中一根被烈火焚燒的橡樹枝得啟示：它在被燃燒時發出光、熱、和悅耳的聲音。不經烈火，它祇是一根冷、硬的殘木。苦難的火焰會使一個冷淡的基督徒火熱起來。

這首詩的作者是凱利 (Thomas Kelly, 1769-1854)。他父親是一個擁有莊園的愛爾蘭法官，他期望兒子能克紹箕裘。凱利大學畢業後被送去倫敦攻讀法律，為了研讀法律文獻，他學會了希伯來文，有一天他讀到希伯來作家羅曼尼 (William Romaine) 所著的「福音教義」 (Evangelical Doctrines)，聖靈光照他；他在神面前認罪悔改，禁食禱告後，他發現法律不能將他從自己的罪性中釋放出來，祇有靠主寶血赦免，才可因信稱義。

於是他改讀神學，而不為父親所諒。凱利二十三歲時受當時的國教聖公會按牧，他竭立維護「因信稱義」的主張，與國教會發生爭議，主教禁止他講道。凱利離開聖公會後，成立愛爾蘭獨立教會，自己到處巡迴佈道，他講道有力，又擅歌唱。凱利雖遭他家人和教會反對，他仍百折不撓，奉獻他全副精神為主作工。

凱利夫婦熱心助人，經常雪中送炭，慷慨襄助四鄰窮人。1847年，饑荒時期，約有百萬人餓死，他奔跑救助，不遺餘力。他一生殷勤工作，除著作外，共作了765首聖詩，他的詩歌多數是充滿喜樂、讚美、信心和盼望。

1854年他中風癱瘓，垂危時，友人為他唸詩篇廿三篇「**耶和華是你的牧者**」，他說：「**主是我的一切，願主旨意成全。**」


