# Open my eyes

Clara H. Scott (1841-1897) was an American composer and in 1882 became the first woman to publish a volume of original hymns. She died in 1897 after being thrown from her carriage by a spooked horse.

She wrote her most famous hymn, *Open My Eyes, That I May See*, in 1895, inspired by Psalm 119:18. Through my research in the archives of Rockingham Castle I discovered that this hymn opened each of the seances hosted by Florence Culme-Seymour throughout the 1930s. I rewrote Clara's original lyrics to give voice to the women whose presence can still be felt in the Castle today.
