以色列人固然出了埃及，过红海，但以后在旷野飘流了三十八年；我们的灵性也往往如此。雅各从巴旦亚兰回来（创 33:18）惟一的目标，就是回家；他也在归途上经过种种困难。但当雅各到达示剑城的时候，他反因贪爱世界的繁华，竟致徘徊歧途，好似忘了出来的目标。他对世界，置产业，恋恋不舍；对家庭，未负领导之责；对神，有亏欠，未选所许宿愿；对自己，内夜自惭，不敢取用以色列的新名。

基督徒在世乃客旅，我们应常思念上面的事，勿贪恋世界。天上的家才是我们永远的家乡。「在那边」，是我们华美的家，是每个圣徒最后的归宿。主耶稣已为我们准备了住处（约 14:2）但在归返天家的路上，患难无穷，常觉孤苦伶仃，试探引诱令人软弱，更需要主耶稣的带领。

这首「带领我归家，父阿」的作者，即「归家」一诗的同作者。Will L. Thompson 似乎是个「思家」的客旅。1847年11月7日生于美国俄亥俄州 East Liverpool，年轻时在波士顿音乐学校受训练，继往德国深造，其最大心愿乃成为圣诗作家。在世俗音乐界相当有成就之后，转而奉献才华为主使用，尽心尽力则作福音圣诗。

后来他创立了出版公司和经营音乐事业在其家乡并延伸至芝加哥。在俄亥俄州，以巡回献唱自己作品之行，已为众人所熟知。他常以马车为工具，走遍各城各海，呼吁迷失的人“归家”。这首圣诗适合独唱或二重唱，到了副歌再四部合唱，非常美妙感人。
